



Privacy Policy

This privacy statement reflects Lethbridge Land's firm commitment to and respect for your privacy. To this end, the following discloses the information gathering and dissemination practices for this Web site.

The intent of this privacy policy is to detail the information Lethbridge Land may gather about individuals who visit its Web sites, how that information is used and Lethbridge Land 's disclosure practices. Site Usage Information
